What is Grace?

G – God’s Requirement (not elective)

...all of us need to be made right with God by His grace, which is a free gift... through Jesus Christ. Romans 3:24 NCV

Only Jesus has the power to save! His name is the only one in all the world that can save anyone. Acts 4:12

R – Received (not earned)

For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith – and this not from yourselves, it is the free gift of God – not by works, so that no one can boast. Ephesians 2:8-9 NIV

People receive God’s promise by having faith. This happens so the promise can be a free gift. Romans 4:16a NCV

A – Available (not exclusive)

The promise is not only for those people that live under the law of Moses. It is for anyone who lives with faith like Abraham. Romans 4:16b ICB

C - Complete (not partial)

E - Eternal (not conditional)
