Great Choices Require

1. A <u>Harmony</u> Evaluation

Your Word is a lamp to my feet and a light for my path. Psalm 119:105 NIV

2. An Honor Evaluation

The man of integrity walks securely, but he who takescrooked paths will be found out.Proverbs 10:9 NIV

<u>Knowing</u> what is right to do and <u>then not doing it</u> is sin. James 4:17 LB

If someone believes something is wrong, then he shouldn't do it because <u>for him it is wrong.</u> Romans 14:14b LB

3. A <u>Betterment</u> Evaluation

Everything is permissible - but not everything is <u>beneficial</u>... [and] not everything is <u>constructive</u>. 1 Corinthians 10:23 NIV

4. A Freedom Evaluation

All things are lawful for me, but I will not be <u>dominated</u> by anything. 1 Corinthians 6:12b RSV I can do anything I want to IF Christ has not said no, BUT some of these things aren't good for me. Even if I am allowed to do them, I'll refuse to if I think they might get such a grip on me that I can't easily stop when I want to.

5. An Impact Evaluation

Each of us will give an account of himself to God... Try to live in such a way that you will never make your brother stumble by letting him see you doing something he thinks is wrong. Romans 14:12-13 LB

Even if we believe that it makes no difference to the Lord whether we do these things, still we cannot just go ahead and do them to please ourselves; we must bear the 'burden' of being considerate of the doubts and fears of others...

6. The <u>Eternal</u> Evaluation
