## The Stages of Successful Parenting

## 1. Early Years - Primary role - the teacher

(Truth) So the words of the LORD will be, "A command here, a command there. A rule here, a rule there. A little lesson here, a little lesson there." Isaiah 28:13 NCV

(Character) Discipline your children while there is hope. If you don't, you will ruin their lives. Proverbs 19:18 NLT

(Competency) Teach your children to choose the right path, and when they are older, they will remain upon it. Proverbs 22:6 NLT

## 2. Middle Years - Primary role - the mentor

(Trust) Trust in the LORD with all your heart; do not depend on your own understanding. Seek his will in all you do, and he will direct your paths. Proverbs 3:5-6 NLT (Character) My child, don't ignore it when the LORD disciplines you, and don't be discouraged when he corrects you. For the LORD corrects those he loves, just as a father corrects a child in whom he delights. Proverbs 3:11-12 NLT

(Competency) Lazy people want much but get little, but those who work hard will prosper and be satisfied. Proverbs 13:4 NLT

- Mentor them by <u>experiences</u> and <u>examples</u>

#### 3. Adult Years - Primary role - <u>cheerleader</u>

Grandchildren are the crowning glory of the aged; parents are the pride of their children. Proverbs 17:6 NLT
