1. It limits my potential.

For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and
of love, and of a sound mind.2 Timothy 1:7

2. It damages my relationships.

3. It overpowers my happiness.

4. It controls my future.

God's Antidotes to Fear

1. <u>Truth</u>

You will know the truth, and the truth will set you free. John 8:32

2. <u>Love</u>

No fear exists where (God's) love is. Rather, perfect love gets rid of fear, because fear involves punishment. The person who lives in fear doesn't have perfect love. 1 John 4:18

3. <u>Faith</u>

Let your faith be like a shield, and you will be able to stop all the flaming arrows of the evil one. Ephesians 6:16
