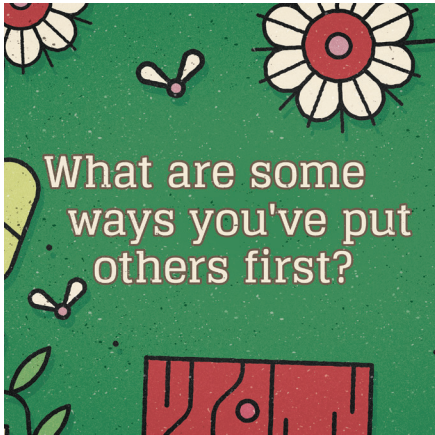

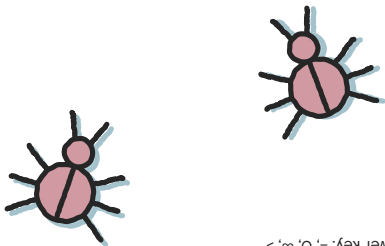

What do you find is the hardest thing for you as you grow in humility? Write that in the blank of the following prayer, then read the prayer out loud to God, asking for help as you live out humility.



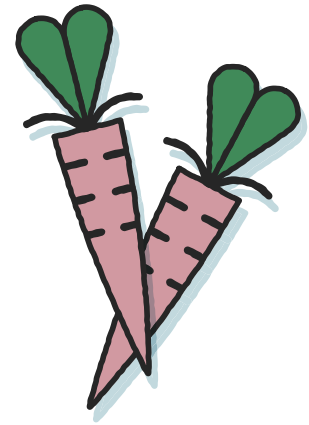
