Read Matthew 28:16-20

Day 3

In Matthew 28:16-20, Matthew includes a sentence that may encourage you as you share God's love with others.

But some still had their doubts. (Matthew 28:17b, NIV)

At some point, you might have some doubts when it comes to your faith. When that happens, know that you're in really good company: even Jesus' disciples who saw Him raised from the dead weren't entirely sure what to believe. Thankfully, Jesus promised He would always be with us!

Read this prayer out loud to God and focus on the truth that Jesus is with you!

"Dear God, Sometimes it's hard to follow You. Help me remember that You are always with me. Thank you for Jesus, help me share His love with others. In Jesus' Name, I pray. Amen."

Day 4
