In this mentoring relationship I may share information with my mentor that is confidential. I understand that my mentor will respect my confidentiality with the following exceptions:

- If my mentor feels they need additional counsel or support, they may have a conversation with a church leader/pastor.
- If I am suicidal and my mentor feels I would harm myself or someone else, it is required by law that my mentor share this information with a leader and/or Pastor to use crisis intervention.
- If my mentor becomes aware or has reasonable cause to believe that a child has been the victim of physical abuse, sexual abuse or neglect, my leader may (and in certain cases must) make a report to the appropriate law enforcement or child protection authorities.
