Agreement

This mentoring relationship will require that I keep information shared with me by a mentee confidential. I may share this information with the leaders of the Mentor Ministry and the Pastors of the church:

- If I feel that the mentee may harm themselves or someone else, it is required by law that I share this information immediately with the leaders of the Mentor Ministry and the Pastor, in order that they may use crisis intervention.
- If I become aware or have reasonable belief that a child has been a victim of physical abuse, sexual abuse or neglect, I will immediately inform my leaders and the Pastor so that my leaders or Pastor may make a report to the appropriate law enforcement or child protection authorities.
- If I need direction and guidance with how to best assist the mentee with their current situation and struggles, I will seek counsel from a Pastor and/or leader.
